Super means above, beyond, higher, surpassing; outside the natural realm; while natural means lower, below, limited to the earthly realm.

Supernatural means something that takes place by divine revelation outside the natural world and human reasoning, that which is above, higher and beyond the ordinary course of nature.

Supernatural abundance is the unlimited, overwhelming supply that comes from above. James 1:17 (AMP) says, *"Every good gift and every perfect (free, large, full) gift is from above; it comes down from the Father of all [that gives] light."*

As you catch the sight of abundance and receive understanding by the Word, you must also hear the sound of abundance. This sound of abundance comes by prophetic encounters, that is, encounters with the prophet and encounters with God's word.

As you stay in the Word, the Word will become specific to your situation and peculiar to you.

God is not limited. He is the supplier of abundance. After you hear the sound, release it by your mouth in conversations and confessions.

### 3. Take the shift

After hearing the sound, you must take the shift into what you have seen and heard by:

**a. Giving:** Giving enlarges your heart and sets you up for consistent and explosive harvest.

**b. Praying:** Prayer breaks opposition and hindrances so that you can receive your harvest.

**c. The Prophet:** Another way that God changes the life of a person and shifts such a person into abundance is by using a prophet to make a declaration that will cause transformation and attract abundance to the person's life.

Faith in God is not denying the existing fact; it is changing the existing fact with the greater truth of God's powerful and effective word.

God does not want you to consider contrary evidence when the devil offers it to you. Rather, God wants you to be strong in faith. When your faith is stronger, the devil is always defeated.

Picture a tree that has been uprooted but the leaves are still growing. The truth however is that the leaves that are growing only appear to be alive but they are no more alive. In the same way, when you prayed to God, the problem has been dealt with.

The symptom is just an appearance of life that will dry off after some time if you don't give up your stand of faith.

One of the enemies of intercession is **gossip**. The Holy Spirit cannot mantle upon your spirit to birth forth the purpose of God on the earth with gossip in your life.

To be useful to God in the ministry of intercession, you will need to cultivate a humble heart before the Lord. No matter who we are or what God is doing through us, we must learn to give God the glory. You must never be too big in your own eyes.

There are spiritual oppositions that will fight to prevent you from getting answers when you are interceding. Angels are fighting, the forces of heaven are also raging and they need you to keep up until there is a manifestation.
