God's word is the ultimate leader that you need not ignore. Don't accept or carry out any communication or counsel from any spiritual leader or even an angel who appears to you either in a vision or dream unless such communication or counsel aligns totally with God's word.

There are two vital reasons you need to submit to higher authority. The first reason is to avoid the wrath of God; when you don't submit to higher authority, you will attract the judgment of God that will result in destruction/losses. The second reason you need to submit to higher authority is so that your conscience will not be dead.

Every time you violate an emblem or a symbol of authority, you deaden your conscience a little bit more.

Also, every time you obey a symbol of authority, you awaken your conscience a little bit more so much so that when you come to a place that you need to make a life and death decision in a very short time, your conscience will alert you.

John 10:1-5; Psalms 23:1-6

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**T**oday, in the body of Christ, people know the voice of many strangers, and this ought not to be.

The Bible says we are sheep as Christians, and sheep don't lead themselves, they follow a leader.

Christians should understand that God has placed the voice of His ministry of “Shepherd” in the ministry and calling of the pastors He gives to us. Therefore, when a pastor is functioning in the supernatural office and anointing of a pastor, we hear the voice of our Chief Shepherd and not the voice of any human being.

You can be a Christian with the Holy Ghost inside of you and choose another leader apart from the Holy Spirit. You need to make up your mind as a sheep in the sheepfold to follow the Chief Shepherd (Jesus) through the human shepherd (genuine man/woman of God).

You need to submit to godly leaders to lead you, feed you, care for you, direct you, guide you, correct you, rebuke you and assign you duties.

Christians need to understand that God gives us shepherds as part of His guidance and protection system. At all times, every Christian must be able to say, “this is my pastor, this is my shepherd” – someone who has accepted responsibility for your life, not just a nominal title.

One of the principles you must imbibe as a believer is to master how to profit by visible leaders that God has identified for you.

Some invisible leaders bring divine signals and communication to you and this includes your spirit, the anointing and dreams. When you receive communications or direction from an invisible leader that seems unclear or you are confused at a point, get confirmation on what to do from a visible leader.

The word of God does not contradict what the Holy Spirit tells you. The major challenge is not the word of God nor the Holy Spirit but what you received and who you received it from.

If there is a conflict between what you have received and the word of God, then you need to admit that you are wrong and seek for confirmation from a visible leader that God has chosen for you. God cannot be wrong and His word cannot be wrong as well.

You must always remember that God's word remains accurate, infallible and profitable for doctrine, reproof, correction and instruction. [2 Timothy 3:16]

You must be ready to admit when you are wrong. If you have spent enough time studying and meditating on God's word, you will know what God cannot say.

Everyone has a way that God speaks or communicates with them. In communicating with God, He doesn't change His pattern with you. Anytime you receive another pattern different from how God communicates with you, it is a dangerous signal that you need to check critically and avoid.

It is important to note that the pattern with which God relates with you will confirm any divine leading that comes to you through any invisible leader.

The same pattern God used to communicate with Samuel in the house of Eli was the same pattern He came to him several times on his journey. It was the same pattern God used when He told Samuel to go and anoint a king in the house of Jesse.

As you journey through life as a believer, you must never neglect or downplay the pattern(s) that God uses to communicate to you; it is your navigator to your appointed destination in life. When you ignore or downplay such pattern(s), you endanger your life.

Prophecy also shows you divine positions that God is leading you to. It can be a word in a creative form bringing forth what is not there initially. Prophecy can also be in form of revelations, in a way that it gives insight into God's purposes for you.

Prophecy that is of God will surely align with His word (the Bible). Any prophecy that doesn't align with God's word is not of God.

When you receive a leading that takes you out of God's prophecy, such leading will lead you into error.

One task the devil goes about doing is trying to ensure that believers are deceived and manipulated out of God's plan and purpose for their lives and one channel he (the devil) can use to deceive is prophecy. Don't be a desperate and easy to confuse believer. Always spend quality time with God.

Isaac had a prophecy and followed God's instruction. Despite the opposition he faced to get out from the land, he still dwelt in the valley of Gerar.

Never move away from where your prophecy is to happen due to economic hardship, emotional feelings and false prophecy from men. Don't allow the devil trick you out of your blessing. Whatever contradicts as little as one principle or truth of the Bible, drop it! It cannot be God because God will never violate His word.

## **GUIDANCE IN UNCERTAINTY (1)**

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**I**f God has not told you what to do in a particular instance, He expects you to follow a visible godly leader. Imbibe the nature that follows the leader.

When you start practising the principle of following the visible godly leader, it will deliver you from making errors.

Wavering means to stagger between two opinions: believing God one moment and doubting Him the next. It is like trying to plant a seed while constantly digging it up to see if it is growing.

You must understand that no prayer prevails when your heart is unsteady.

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**G**od said in Jeremiah 1:12, “...*for I will hasten my word to perform it.*” Notice that God did not promise to perform your worries, fears or complaints - He promised to perform His words.

Confidence in prayer flows from knowing His promises and presenting them back to Him. When you pray the Word, you are not begging God to do something new; you are aligning yourself with what He has already declared.

Many believers do not get results because their prayers are vague, unscriptural or rooted in human desires rather than divine will.

## **CONFIDENCE THAT BRINGS RESULTS (3)**

1 John 5:14-15; Jeremiah 1:12

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**P**rayer is not about bending God's arm; it is all about agreeing with His will. Until your prayers agree with God's will, they will remain unanswered.

You must develop the habit of searching the Scriptures before praying. Find out what God has said concerning your need and then present it boldly to Him.

Don't go to God with empty words; go with covenant terms. As you do, confidence rises and results follow. Let every request you make be anchored on Scripture. Heaven honours the Word and the Word secures your answers.

## **THE POWER OF ASKING ACCORDING TO GOD'S WILL (1)**

John 15:7; James 4:3

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**T**he secret to effective prayer is not in the volume of words but in alignment with God's will.

Jesus declared, *"If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."* [John 15:7]

The condition is clear: abiding in Him and letting His Word abide in you. When His Word shapes your desires, your prayers automatically align with His will and answers become inevitable. But when prayer springs only from human wants or fleshly ambition, it loses power before heaven.

## **THE POWER OF ASKING ACCORDING TO GOD'S WILL (2)**

John 15:7; James 4:3

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**J**ames explains why many prayers go unanswered: *"Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts."* [James 4:3]

God does not finance lust. He will not endorse requests that contradict His purpose or corrupt your soul.

For example, a man asking God to bless his dishonesty in business is praying against divine laws. No matter how long he prays, such prayers will never be answered. This is why you must let the Word of God filter your requests.

## **THE POWER OF ASKING ACCORDING TO GOD'S WILL (3)**

John 15:7; James 4:3

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**P**rayers born from Scriptures are prayers God is already eager to answer. They rest not on emotion but on covenant truth.

Learn to check your motives before you pray. Ask yourself: does this request glorify God or just satisfy me? Is my request consistent with His promises or is it driven by mere carnal desires?

Don't waste energy praying amiss. Anchor your desires in the Word and present them boldly. When the Word rules your asking, you will not only pray effectively but also live in greater harmony with God's will.
