PRAYER







PRAYER







PRAYER



PRAYER



PRAYER



That some wealthy people got their wealth by doing something ungodly doesn't make wealth in itself wrong. Getting wealth legitimately should be your mindset.

- 1. Weakness
- 2. Spiritual impotence (no force in their spirit)

However, when you rightly discern the body of Christ at the Holy Communion table, these three will not be part of your experience. In the Old Testament, they didn't joke with the Passover, but the Corinthian Church didn't take it seriously; they came to the Communion table to take their dinner because they saw it as a free meal in church.

Most of the problems people face in marriage are centred on their differences. Most times, we have not adequately recognized the differences in strength between men and women or celebrated them.
