James 3:2-12

1. **Identify what you want or what you are dealing with:** Place an identity on your desires or trouble. Faith prayers are focused and deliberate not vague.
 2. **Get a promise for what you want:** Search the scriptures to see what God has said or promised on that matter you identified.

4. Act in accordance with the promise and your confession: Your actions should be in accordance with God's promise and your confessions

5. Start calling those things that be not as though they are: What you need exists in the spirit realm and the more you call it forth, the more it manifests - your words give life to it.

1 John 4:4

Any time you are praying, take the opportunity to ensure that you run the devil out of your life totally. Don't give him any more room to fester and flourish in your life either directly or indirectly.

Acts 3:3-5

Over the years, God has come to you in many ways and through His servants, words have been spoken over you and processes are in motion for manifestation. However, if you won't cancel the processes, you must be expectant.

This was to the extent that when the angel went to release Peter from prison and led him to the house where they were praying, Peter knocked the door, but they refused to open. The maid recognized his voice but still did not open. She ran back to tell others, but they did not believe because they were not expecting him. They thought the maid must have seen a spirit, but she persisted, and they confirmed and let Peter in.

Isaiah 59:1-2b says, *“Behold, the LORD’s hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God.”* So, your iniquity can separate you from the covenant.

Ignorance can also separate you from the covenant. You need to do all you can to have the right values in your heart.

1 Samuel 17:55-56

Sonship is caught, it is not taught. Sonship is the process by which the forces of the Kingdom of God come upon and flow into human life.

Sonship is that thing that gives you training and preparation. The truth is that the Kingdom forces that make destiny happen only come and flow towards right sonship.

Sonship can be in two sides: wrong sonship and right sonship. Your sonship is the degree to which you are responding correctly to fathering and the demands of God-ordained father on you. Do an evaluation of your life - are you a son indeed?

2 Kings 2:1-14

Elisha had the right sonship in his life. He followed Elijah as a son and when he saw his father being taken away, Elijah's mantle fell on him, and he had a double portion of Elijah's anointing - he caught the spirit of sonship.

David also was a man who caught that spirit. He was so much of a son that his father could send him to his brothers on the field, his father's flock was also safe in his hand. God chose him to be king over His people.

You need to separate from everything that connotes wrong sonship, such as disobedience to instructions and rebellion. Divine inheritance belongs to sons only.

FATHERS TAKE US FURTHER (1)

Psalms 44:1-3

Your earthly father connects you to your ancestral flow, but there is a father who connects you to the Kingdom flow. It is a wise son that strategically builds a relationship of blessing with his father.

A true son does not depend only on his effort; he depends also on his father's involvement. Learn to protect and honor the anointed linkages in your life. These linkages bring divine flow into your life.

Isaiah 51:1-2

Never allow the devil to separate you from divine linkages. When a son knows his father, he has an identity, but if a father acknowledges a son, the son has an inheritance.

You can have some amount of money without prospering. In fact, you can have a lot of money without prospering.

When God formed a nation from the children of Israel, He had a clear purpose and place He was leading them to. Many people today only enjoy God as the gatherer (One who brings us together in church). God wants us to recognize Him as a trainer who has a specific and good destination in mind for us.
